I hope that we continue to grow and develop this coming season, including the new players who have joined us.</p>	
Coaching Team report	<p>We currently have 2 BHUK DBS checked coaches within the club. We continue to train for two hours, once a week, with training sessions remaining open to our own team members as well as players from other teams who wish to attend. This allows these players to access additional training for their own development, as well as improving the standard of training sessions to enable our own players to develop.</p> <p>Entered 2 league teams in BHUK central conference and finished second and sixth. We had several players playing their first ever season of ball hockey, so this was a fantastic</p>	

	<p>achievement. Entered into BHUK tier 3 nationals and competed two of the 4 qualifying tournaments. Due to clashes with other BHUK events, short notice and date changes we were unfortunately unable to attend the other qualifying events. We also entered the veterans club tournament, where we had a fantastic day of hockey, competing against some top quality teams and were really proud to be able to field a team of Nemesis players, as well as enabling one of the Manchester players to join us, as he wanted to play but did not have a local team entering the even.</p> <p>We had 8 players across multiple teams away during this summer representing GB for BHUK.</p> <p>We will be entering two teams into the league next season, to enable all players wanting to play, to play, without anyone having to miss out due to the maximum bench size of 12 players per game. We will be aiming to improve on our 'second place' league finish from last season, with the goal of having a team in each league to further allow development of our players and team. And we are soon to have a second alternate Nemesis Kit.</p>
